Legal Aid Society of San Diego provides free legal assistance with its *Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic (LITC).* They are <u>not</u> a part of or affiliated with the Internal Revenue Service. Through our in-house tax attorney, or pro bono volunteer attorneys, we also represent low-income taxpayers in Tax Court, when appropriate.

What Types of Tax Problems Do We Handle?

Our Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic helps Taxpayers with *federal individual income tax matters*.

Some of the kinds of federal tax matters that the Clinic handles include:

- IRS Audits.
- IRS Collection Notices.
- IRS Liens and Garnishments.
- IRS Demands to File Tax Returns for Past Years.
- IRS Notices of Tax
 Deficiencies
- IRS Notices to Assess Taxes based on income of a Taxpayer's ex-spouse.
- Notices or actions by IRS disallowing a Taxpayer's claim of the Earned Income Credit.

• Problems involving the theft of a Taxpayer's social security number by another person for tax purposes.
