TYPES OF CASES WE HANDLE

LASSD attorneys specialize in many different areas of civil and administrative law. Contact us if you need free legal assistance with the following issues:

Housing and Evictions

Tenant assistance with evictions/unlawful detainers, notices, subsidized housing, mobile homes, housing discrimination, reasonable accommodation requests, foreclosure, etc.

Health Care Access

Help obtaining and maintaining health coverage, Medi-Cal eligibility, overcoming access to healthcare barriers, behavioral health grievances, patients' rights, etc.

Public Benefits

CalWorks, CalFresh, General Relief, CAPI, KinGap, etc.

Consumer Protection

Debt collection, solar scams, bankruptcy, auto loans, medical debt, student loans, payday loans, foreclosure prevention, etc.

Family

Services for custodial parents and survivors of domestic violence including divorce, custody, parentage, visitation, etc.

Immigration

Family-based petitions, adjustment of status, naturalization and citizenship, waivers, public charge info, immigration court, VAWA, U and T Visas, etc.

Special Education Issues

IEPs, 504 services, IEEs, due process, mediations, suspension and expulsion issues for students with disabilities, etc.

Federal Taxpayer Rights

Audits, missing tax refunds, payment plans and collection alternatives, representation before the US Tax Court, etc.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

SSI applications for adults and children, reconsiderations, hearings, appeals, reviews, etc. (Note: special referral rules apply)
